Outside

There is a small courtyard at the rear of the property with enough space for a table and chairs and some strategically placed plants.

Location

The market town, with its impressive produce market every Wednesday and Saturday, is nestled in the heart of Suffolk. It is known for the Abbey Gardens, a ruined abbey right in the town centre. Bury is a very popular destination for locals and tourists to the area. Visit the old side of the town to see the Cathedral in all its glory, the medieval quarter of the town and the Abbey Gardens itself, or browse the newer side of the town to discover its large assortment of shops, restaurants and entertainment centres.

The house occupies a prominent setting within the historic town centre. Bury St Edmunds is a picturesque, thriving market town which brings together the old and the new and is a very popular destination to reside or to visit. The town enjoys an excellent range of shopping facilities, Theatre Royal, the Cathedral, Abbey Gardens, and numerous facilities to cater for a wide range of general interests. Excellent links to major roads including the A14 offering excellent access to Ipswich in one direction and Cambridge and London to the other.

Directions

On foot from our office on Whiting Street. Head away from the town centre and at the crossroads turn left, take the next turning on the right hand side into College Street. Follow College Street for a couple of hundred yards and then turn left into Church Walks. Follow Church Walks for a short distance where number 9 can be found on the left hand side.

Services


All mains services are connected and benefits from a gas-fired heating system and permit parking. Council Tax Band B.
