

## Description

Two rarely available amenity sites located on the southern periphery of the sought after Perthshire conservation village of Comrie. Measuring 2acres & 0.36acres respectively, the larger is a level field lying adjacent to the Braco Road (B827) enclosed by post & wire fencing. The smaller area is of hilly terrain with a covering of mature trees & shrubbery. A private track, which services four residential properties, provides access to the sites. 




Comrie is a beautiful and lively village nestling on the banks of the River Earn, some 7 miles west of Crieff, 25miles from the historic cities of Perth and Stirling and 50/60 miles respectively to the centre of Glasgow and Edinburgh. There are a number of independent shops in the village along with hotels, restaurants, medical centre and dentist. There is Primary schooling in Comrie with both private & public education available within Crieff. The area is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts, with river, woodland/hill/mountain walks surrounding the village, renowned mountain biking at 'Comrie Croft' and water sports at Loch Earn (6miles).
