Directions

Travelling from Perth, head north on the A9 and take the eventual turn off on the left at Ballinluig signposted for Aberfeldy. Continue into Aberfeldy and then the eventual road on the right signposted for Weem, Kinloch Rannoch and Glen Lyon. Head over the bridge across the River Tay and through Weem (B846). Continue approximately 5 miles until reaching a road on the left signposted for Fortingall. Shortly after Fortingall turn right at the signposted junction leading you direct to Loch Lyon passing through Invervar and Bridge of Balgie. The small winding road will take you past a small reservoir on the left (Stronuich near Cashlie) and onto a small cluster of properties on the right just before reaching Loch Lyon itself. Go through the white gate on the right and follow the track round and no.2 is the penultimate property on the right. An alternative route from the West is via Killin along the north shore of Loch Tay turning left at Fearnan.
